3. Discussion/Action: To retain legal counsel concerning agreement for new library

The Board discussed the need for a real estate attorney to represent the Library's interests with Colbalt Partners to finalize the agreement for the space donation at One North. Funds are available for this in the capital budget. Cobalt Partners needs the agreement in place to secure funding for the project. An attorney can assist the Library in determining what our best options are in terms of owning or leasing the space, and if owned should there be a condominium type of agreement. The municipalities will not be the owners of the space. We have a proposal from Deborah Tomczyk, a well-regarded Milwaukee real estate attorney. She has worked with Cobalt Partners in the past. Glaisner stated that we should receive more than one proposal.

Anderson-Knight/Grady moved to hire a legal representative for the building project, find out the number of hours expected for this work, and determine whether we own or lease the space. Motion carried unanimously.
